## Summary of changes

The following changes will be implemented in the Queensland Hospital Admitted Patient Data Collection (QHAPDC) for the 2022-2023 data collection period to meet Department of Health, State and National reporting requirements. These changes will be applied to the *public facility file formats* as referenced in the table below.

<p><b>1. ICD-10-AM/ACHI 12<sup>th</sup> Edition</b></p> <p>ICD-10-AM/ACHI 12<sup>th</sup> Edition will be used for morbidity coding by all Australian States and Territories, replacing ICD-10-AM/ACHI 11<sup>th</sup> Edition morbidity coding for admitted patient episodes of care with a separation date from 1 July 2022 inclusive.</p>	Public File Format – pages 33 and 69
<p><b>2. AR-DRG Version 10.0 to continue being reported by facilities providing hospital services</b></p> <p>Due to delays in the release of AR-DRG Grouper Version 11 by the Independent Hospitals Pricing Authority (IHPA), AR-DRG Grouper Version 10.0 software will be enhanced by the vendor to read the new ICD-10-AM/ACHI, 12<sup>th</sup> Edition codes. This will ensure the allocation of Version 10.0 DRGs that align with the Queensland Department of Health Activity Based Funding (ABF) Model for admitted patient separations for 2022-2023. Updates to the AR-DRG grouper software will be managed by DAS Clinical, eHealth Queensland.</p>	
<p><b>3. ICD-10-AM/ACHI 12<sup>th</sup> Edition – Terminology update required from ‘Date of procedure’ to ‘Date of intervention’</b></p> <p>In line with ICD-10-AM/ACHI 12<sup>th</sup> Edition, a terminology update from ‘Date of Procedure’ to ‘Date of Intervention’ is required. This is evidenced by the Australian Coding Standards (ACS) such as ACCS 0019 Intervention abandoned, interrupted or not completed.</p>	Public File Format – pages 34 and 69

<p><b>4. ICD-10-AM/ACHI 12<sup>th</sup> Edition – Mandatory block ranges requiring intervention date</b></p> <p>Due to the new blocks and codes as part of ACHI 12<sup>th</sup> Edition, the code blocks that require an intervention date has been updated to reflect these changes.</p> <p>1 to 1059  1062 to 1821  1825 to 1866  1869 to 1892  1894 to 1912  1920 to 2016  8888 to 8889</p>	<p>Public File Format – pages 34 and 69</p>
<p><b>5. Telehealth Telehandover functionality – 3 new data items</b></p> <p>The Telehealth Support Unit – Healthcare Improvement Unit, Clinical Excellence Queensland has requested this enhancement for the HQI extract to be updated in relation to the new Telehealth Telehandover functionality. These three new data items are only required for reporting for telehealth sessions with a start date on or after 1 July 2022 with an event type '25 – Telehandover':</p> <p>Recipient Facility; Recipient Type; and Recipient Unit</p> <p><i>A corresponding HBCIS enhancement in the June 2022 release will contain an update to include these 3 new data items.</i></p>	<p>Public File Format – page 56 and 83</p>
