

How to clean a foot spa at the end of the day

How to clean a foot spa at the end of the day

Follow the process for 'cleaning a foot spa between clients'

Wash & dry hands before & after cleaning equipment

Use clean gloves when cleaning equipment



At the end of the day, drain the water from the foot spa

Wipe the foot spa thoroughly with detergent and warm water using a clean cloth or disposable paper towel to remove all contamination



Flush the foot spa clean with water

Use an alcohol wipe or alcohol spray to wipe the surface of the foot spa



Follow manufacturers instructions to remove components such as inlet jets and filter screens

Clean with a brush, warm/hot water & suitable cleaning agent

Rinse components with clean water & reassemble



For 're-circulating foot spas' re-fill with clean water and a disinfectant solution

Check disinfectant manufacturer's instructions for contact times for disinfection



After disinfecting drain, rinse and dry the foot spa

Keep the foot spa clean and dry overnight or until next use
