Here's the breakdown.

Total - 161 employees – ieMR staff working on the rollout (centre of excellence eHealth)

111 staff – non clinicians

32 clinicians

18 contractors

Gordon Laurie and Renaie Collins are both clinicians. Gordon is part-time with eHealth and the remainder with Metro South. We understand Renaie still has a substantive role at Metro South. So both are still with QH.

Their contracts with eHealth were both due to finish June 30.
