RMO Campaign 2022

In Queensland, **Advanced Training in Clinical Immunology and Allergy** is managed centrally by a panel comprised of Clinical Immunology Directors from accredited training facilities. The selection process includes a panel interview with Directors (or delegates) from each participating training facility. Positions will be allocated primarily according to ranking during interview and other mitigating circumstances.
