Description: Evaluating the change refers to knowing if practice changed and the implementation strategies used had an effect. This section will provide guidance in planning the measurement of your practice change including implementation quality, service and clinical outcomes.

Learning Objectives

- 1) Understand evaluation concepts to select appropriate evaluation indicators
- 2) Distinguish between the aims of intervention vs. implementation outcomes and the role they play in evaluation
- 3) Evaluate implementation quality (including feasibility, acceptability, fidelity etc)
- 4) Use an evaluation framework to guide evaluation

1. Ask participants to list out 1) the audience and 2) the purpose of the evaluation for the TRIP project. Consider what is important for them to understand about your project moving forward.
 - a. Discuss how you might find this out from your audience
2. Go back to the understanding a problem worksheet
 - a. How did you know there was a problem at the time?
 - b. How did you measure this problem?
 - c. How do you know if your practice change has had an effect? What did you think success would look like

**prompt the group to consider which of these 'problem' measures may be useful in the evaluation

3. Ask the group use the logic model template to map out your project

****Start with the outcome (what problem are you trying to solve) and work backwards may help**

- a. When reviewing a logic model consider what the corresponding evaluation questions are

Revisit the first activity – ask the group to circle the evaluation questions on your logic model that best meet the needs of the evaluation audience and the purpose of the evaluation

Watch the remaining webinars –is there a theoretical approach to evaluation that might help structure the teams thinking about measuring implementation outcomes in your project example? Share with the group

Evaluation is important to consider in the planning phases of any TRIP project to decide what are important indicators to include verse what can be left out
