

The data presented in tables 1-3 represent selected admitted patient episodes of care in Queensland acute public hospitals, with a separation date between 1 July 2012 and 31 March 2013. These data have been sourced from the Queensland Hospital Admitted Patient Data Collection (QHAPDC).

Table 1 represents admitted patient episodes of care where malnutrition (ICD10-AM code E40-E46) was recorded in QHAPDC as either the principal diagnosis or secondary/other diagnosis, and where the patient died in hospital during that episode. These 788 episodes of care have been separated into the ICD10-AM Chapters of the principal diagnosis for that episode; e.g. if malnutrition was recorded as a secondary diagnosis and the principal diagnosis was a particular cancer, then that episode is assigned to Chapter 2 Neoplasms.

Table 1 also reports whether malnutrition was recorded as being present on admission or not. For the 788 episodes of care that reported malnutrition as either a principal or secondary diagnosis, and the patient died in hospital during that episode, 754 of these reported malnutrition as being present on admission.

Table 2 represents admitted patient episodes of care where dehydration (ICD10-AM code E86) was recorded in QHAPDC as either the principal diagnosis or secondary/other diagnosis, and where the patient died in hospital during that episode. As per table 1, these 895 episodes of care have been separated into the ICD10-AM Chapter of the principal diagnosis, and also report whether dehydration was recorded as being present on admission. For the 895 episodes of care that reported malnutrition as either a principal or secondary diagnosis, and the patient died in hospital during that episode, 732 of these reported dehydration as being present on admission.

Table 3 is restricted to only those admitted patient episodes where malnutrition or dehydration was reported as being the principal diagnosis, and the patient died in hospital during that episode. Table 3 also reports whether the malnutrition of dehydration was present on admission, and the broad age-group of that patient. For all 26 admitted patient episodes where malnutrition or dehydration was the principal diagnosis and the patient died in hospital during that episode, the condition of malnutrition or dehydration was reported as being present on admission. Of these 26 patients, 8 had a principal diagnosis of malnutrition; these 8 patients represented 0.10% of the total number of patients that died in Queensland public acute hospitals between 1 July 2012 and 31 March 2013. The other 18 patients had a principal diagnosis of dehydration; these 18 patients represented 0.22% of the total number of patients that died in Queensland public acute hospitals between 1 July 2012 and 31 March 2013.
