



- Pine Rivers group has stepped in on Thursday as a result of XXX (because of Communities?);
- QH has been asked to consider payment to that group, to provide for continuity of service;
- What our view on that is (obviously I don't think we have any concerns with that approach?)
- Noting that RCAMB have today issued media statement indicating they are appointing a liquidator to wind-up;
- Any discussions/views we have from Communities (I don't know it you did hear from their Regional Director over the weekend I didn't).

DG will then (if it's our recommendation) approve release of the funds following further confirmation from Govt. If i can get that by 3pm, I can get it signed of topay.






