Good evening Michael,

Confirming our phone discussion, the minor changes we have made to the terminology used by our operational staff when tweeting was a decision made by the Commissioner after a conversation I had with him about making our tweets more simple for the general public to understand and in turn be reflective of the work we undertake. We have requested our operational staff tweet more current happening events that may affect the public in their daily lives. At no stage have we stopped telling the public that a hospital is busy we are doing so as required but in simple English getting away from the technical and confusing terms of escalation levels.

Twitter is also being used to inform the media, especially radio networks of certain jobs that are of interest to them.

Below are some examples we have provided our operational staff to work with.

## RTCs (Road traffic crashes)

Paramedics on scene at a truck rollover Gateway Mwy & Nudgee Rd off-ramp #Nudgee. Nil injuries at this stage

Paramedics are treating 2 women & a man for minor injuries after a 2-vehicle crash at Kingston & Wembley Rds #LoganCentral about 12.50pm.

QAS treating 8 people after 4WD rollover on Fraser Island. 1 man with head & facial injuries to be airlifted. Others have minor injuries

Paramedics are treating two people at the scene of a two-vehicle crash at Brunswick & Terrace Sts #NewFarm.

A 43yo woman was taken to Gympie Hospital with minor injuries after she was hit by a car on Mary St #Gympie about 3.30pm.

Man in his 20s with possible leg fracture taken stable to Cairns Base Hospital after car & motorbike crash on Pease St #Manoora #Cairns

20yo man w/minor injuries taken stable to Townsville Hosp after vehicle hit a building on Marabou Dr #Annandale #Townsville

Man in his 60s w/ minor knee graze taken stable to Redlands Hospital after vehicle & cyclist incident Florence St & Wynnum Esp #Wynnum

One man involved in a truck rollover Hawken Dr #StLucia just after 7.15am. Assessed by paramedics, no transport required
